



Fred Whitton Challenge : Sunday May 13th 2012 Entry Details + Sponsored Entry Form

The tourist traffic and narrow Lake District roads mean we have to limit the number of riders. And this year's event is over-subscribed and all standard entry places are now taken. However the event is for charity, so we have kept some extra places available for people who will guarantee to raise at least £250 sponsorship for the event charities, by paying that guaranteed sponsorship 'up-front' with entry. This entry pack can only be used for this guaranteed sponsorship form of entry.

Before entering, using the entry form at the end, please read all the following notes. And note that **all** riders in the event **must wear a helmet**, no tri-bars and **no entries allowed on the day**.

Entry Fee

The entry fee (in addition to sponsorship) is £40 per rider (payable to "The Fred Whitton Challenge"), and must be sent with entry. The fee includes electronic timing, 2 feed stations plus a small meal at the finish, a certificate of your ride and free parking at Coniston Sports Centre field (weather permitting). The event is volunteer organised and run, and after expenses all remaining money from the entry fee, and all sponsorship, is donated to the event charities.

Entry Fee is not Refundable: If your entry is successful and you later cancel then all of your fee will go to the event charities. However if for some reason you can't ride the event and you let us know and cancel your place at least two weeks before the event and we find a rider to take your place, then we will save you a place in next year's event.

How to Enter for a Guaranteed Sponsorship place

To apply for a Guaranteed-Sponsored place, please complete the special Guaranteed-Sponsored entry form at the end of this pack, and send it with your cheque for the £40 entry fee and the £250 guaranteed sponsorship.

Please also enclose an A5 stamped self-addressed envelope (SAE) with your entry. This is for us to use to send you your event leaflet, rider number, etc. a couple of weeks before the event. An ordinary 2nd class stamp is sufficient on your SAE unless your SAE envelope is thick or large enough to need a 'Large Letter' stamp. And please also be careful to put the correct postage on the envelope you send your entry in - the Post Office charge us a penalty if your postage isn't correct, so entries without correct postage won't be accepted.
